## Bobbin Lounge Chair #1205

The turned "bobbin" technique of the 17th century was employed to reduce the bulkiness of the furniture and later became synonymous with the English "rural" style.

Dimensions: 30"w x 34"d x 40"h w/ Castors at front

Wood: Alder (shown)

Wood option: Walnut, African Mahogany, White Oak

Finish: "Worn Ebonized Beech" on Alder, medium distress w/ hand planing

& Stained Rush (shown)

Finish option: Any, including "Italian Fruitwood" on Alder with Raw Rush (shown)

Rush option: Raw Rush, Stained to match finish, Honey Seal

UPH: Loose down wrap seat & down back cushion, flat welt

COM: 4.5 yard plain Optional COT: 2 yards plain

VARIATION Dining Armchair, Dining Side Chair, Bar Stool, Counter Stool, Ottoman,

Settee, Loveseat, Bed
