## FURNITURE

Dimensions: 28"w x 24"d x 19"h

Wood: Alder (shown)

Wood option: Walnut, White Oak, African Mahogany

Finish: “Worn Ebonized Beech” on Alder, medium distress with hand planing & rush stained to match (shown)

Finish option: Any

Rush option: Raw, Stained to match finish, Honey Seal

UPH option: Loose down wrap seat and down fill back cushions, flat welt

COM: 2 yards plain

VARIATION Ottoman, Dining Armchair, Side Chair, Bar Stool, Counter Stool, Settee, Bed
