Dimensions: 76.5"w x 36"d x 40"h w/ Castors at front

Wood: Alder (shown)

Wood option: Walnut, African Mahogany, White Oak

Finish: "Worn Ebonized Beech" on Alder, medium distress w/ hand planing

& stained rush (shown)

Finish option: Any

Rush option: Raw Rush, Stained to match finish, Honey Seal

UPH: Loose down wrap seat & down back cushion, flat welt

COM: 12 yard plain Optional COT: 3 yards plain

VARIATION No castors
