Wood option: Alder, Walnut, African Mahogany

Finish: “Italian Oak” on Oak, medium distress w/ hand planing & Raw Rush (shown)

Finish option: Any, including “Worn Ebonized Beech” on Alder w/ Stained Rush (shown above)

Rush options: Raw Rush, Stained to match finish, Honey Seal
